Wage - How much you get paid per hour of work

Minimum Wage - The minimum you are allowed to pay someone per hour

Income - How much you get paid for work

 $Income = Wage \times Time$ 

#### 1 Hour of Work

 $\$8.80 \ per \ hour \times 1 \ hour = \$8.80$ 

#### 2 Hours of Work

 $$8.80 \ per \ hour \times 2 \ hour = $17.60$ 

#### 3 Hours of Work

 $\$8.80 \ per \ hour \times 3 \ hour = \$26.40$ 

#### 4 Hours of Work

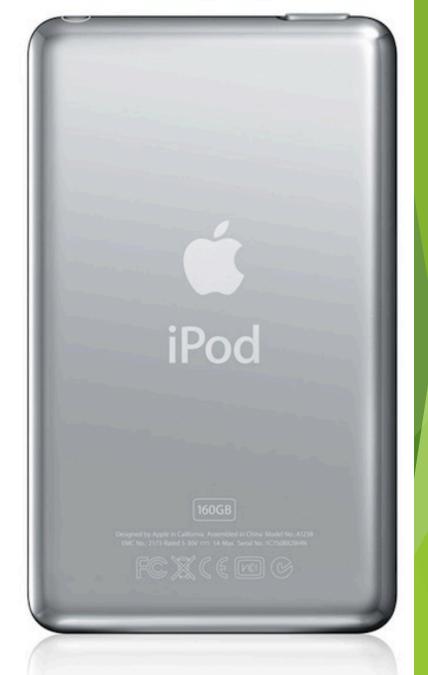
 $$8.80 \ per \ hour \times 4 \ hour = $35.20$ 

If Mr. G worked for 25 hours during the month of June, how much money did he make? (Wage = \$8.80 per hour)

 $\$8.80 \ per \ hour \times 25 \ hours = \$220$ 







How many hours did Mr. G have to work at Edo Japan (\$8.80 per hour) to buy an iPod Classic (\$380)?

$$\frac{\$380}{\$8.80 \ per \ hour} = 43.2 \ hours \rightarrow 44 \ hours$$

#### Bonus:

If Mr. G worked 4 hour shifts every Saturday, how many shifts would he have to work to buy the iPod Classic?

$$\frac{43.2 \ hours}{4 \ hours \ per \ shift} = 10.8 \ shifts \rightarrow 11 \ shifts$$
