Edo Japan

\$8.80 per hour



Wage - How much you get paid per hour of work

Minimum Wage - The minimum you are allowed to pay someone per hour

Income - How much you get paid for work

$$\textit{Income} = \textit{Wage} \times \textit{Time}$$

1 Hour of Work

$$\text{\$8.80 per hour} \times 1 \text{ hour} = \text{\$8.80}$$

2 Hours of Work

$$\text{\$8.80 per hour} \times 2 \text{ hour} = \text{\$17.60}$$

3 Hours of Work

$$\text{\$8.80 per hour} \times 3 \text{ hour} = \text{\$26.40}$$

4 Hours of Work

$$\text{\$8.80 per hour} \times 4 \text{ hour} = \text{\$35.20}$$

If Mr. G worked for 25 hours during the month of June, how much money did he make? (Wage = \$8.80 per hour)

$$\text{\$8.80 per hour} \times 25 \text{ hours} = \text{\$220}$$



How many hours did Mr. G have to work at Edo Japan (\$8.80 per hour) to buy an iPod Classic (\$380)?

$$\frac{\$380}{\$8.80 \text{ per hour}} = 43.2 \text{ hours} \rightarrow 44 \text{ hours}$$

Bonus:

If Mr. G worked 4 hour shifts every Saturday, how many shifts would he have to work to buy the iPod Classic?

$$\frac{43.2 \text{ hours}}{4 \text{ hours per shift}} = 10.8 \text{ shifts} \rightarrow 11 \text{ shifts}$$
